In that draft we need to develop a job description and tenants. The High level church can become the foundation of the constitution. We need to articulate all Orders. There needs to be an episcopal voice in the process

The majority felt that it was not time to call for candidates.

There was a call for a day of prayer and/or setting up a prayer calendar. A prayer calendar elicits more personal connections.

We need to get a sense of who we are as a region. Start at the communities and bring it forward to a regional meeting. The goal for the regional meeting was in February. The meetings would provide input from the communities for next steps and ways to get involved in the process.

Finally we decided to reach out to the other dioceses or forming diocese. Dennis will talk to the North West Diocese, Jack will talk to the Mid-American Diocese and Michael will talk to the

California Diocese. We want to know what worked, pitfalls, How did they go about developing the characteristics or job description of a bishop and copies of their respective constitutions.

Tina Yankee**, CCC's late Director of Programs and Development – Tina chaired our Criminal Justice Reform Task Force, championed Income Equality, and worked on issues related to affordable housing/homelessness, the environment and ecumenical relations. She was also a coordinator of our Voices For Justice Task Force.

Board Members are asked to step up to fulfill some of the holes Tina's death has left, especially during the legislative session.

Public **Policy Statement on Ethical Eating** being wordsmithed; Board impressed with points raised by Mthr. Kae's agriculture connection, but is at a quandary about whose voices to include. Michael was asked to suggest possible contributors.

Finances reviewed. RMRC dues up to date.

All Board members asked to identify possible donors to receive end-of-year appeal letter and/or make a personal contribution. Please let me know if any members of our ECC communities might be receptive to this appeal.

Bill Pounds, Regional VP of Five Rings Financial, gave presentation on Indexed Annuities as a possible way to build an endowment for funding the Annual East Sunrise Service.

Approved Shine the Light Task Force's recommendation to collaborate with the community dialogue initiative **At the Table Colorado**, particularly to increase awareness of homelessness among the population that polls say are least interested: middle-aged white males.

BISHOPS/VICARS CALL 10-17-18

Synod followup

2019/2020 Budget—final circulated to the HOL

2018 General Appeal—Vicars to remind their regions of commitments made at Synod; pick any weekend; due before Thanksgiving, consolidated into one check to the OPB. **Constitution**—6 month extension; Tom Wilding assumptions: amendments (if any) should be made to the version already passed by HOP. I voiced concern about the HOP process of honoring the work of the Commission and George, and passing the majority of the document without review, assuming that we can change things next Synod. George invited to next Bishops/Vicars Call 11/14 to address concerns.

- **Open Vicar positions** for EC and SW Regions; names of possible suggestions forwarded to +Francis.
- Independent Catholic Forum—+Francis hopes to coordinate a gathering of independent Catholic communities/churches in the Fall of 2019. ECUSA thrilled with the prospect.

RMR—shared about Dcn. Cynthia's installation/1st Mass as deacon, and our process moving toward calling a local bishop
