OLD BUSINESS

- 1. <u>Planning for October 11-14, 2024 Holy Synod at YMCA of the Rockies.</u> Leadership Council was absorbed with Mid-America Region issues at its last meeting, and did not get around to discussing Synod planning.
- 2. <u>January 18-25 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity</u>. After discussion it was consensus COB would host a prayer service on ZOOM at 6:30 on Friday January 19th. Prayers will be assigned to each Community participating, and the communities within which we are nested should all be invited to participate.
- 3. <u>ECC101 presentation feedback</u> The intended primary focus was to recruit and educate Synod delegates. The consensus was that the presentation was successful.

Discussion then shifted to the recording of the presentation, with thanks to Tom for his editing. Consensus was that the recording was an improvement over the live presentation. While the dead spaces were removed, many felt that it was still too long. It was felt that a "Table of Contents" with time

offsets showing when each topic began would be a further improvement. The recording should be placed on the RMRC website as a regional resource.

There was a suggestion that the presentation should be divided into perhaps three separate sessions or chapters, to be used by a live presenter to tell the ECC story to potential new members. The recording is mostly slides, and having a live presenter with the slides as backup would be a more powerful message. Don offered to come up with an outline of what this might look like. Don asked that the original presenters e-mail the notes used in their presentations to the Council, if not already in the background notes, to provide more backup to future presenters.

NEW BUSINESS

Community Updates

LOC - Their marketing consultant just presented his Phase 1 report, so the Parish Council has a lot of work in the next months leading up to their All Parish Meeting.

St. Paul - Chris Gilmore, their nested UCC Pastor will present at Saturday Mass on the perspective from the UCC as to how the communities can come together as a Christian Community while retaining St. Paul's Catholic character.

MOM - Focus for Advent is on God's gift of hope.

HF - Tuesday Parish e-blasts include a teaser on the Gospel that is part of the upcoming weekend Mass. Jane is working on increasing the size of the leadership team, and is having one-on-one conversations with all active community members.

COB - They participated in a walk to US Representative Caraveo's offices to encourage her to sign on to the proposed immigration bill.


